Contest Update

Contest Overview

Students will set up a display with the items listed below. They will be given a written test, perform an interview, and pre-produced items will be judged. Students are asked to set-up displays at a designated time and will remain in the contest area from that time until judges dismiss the contestants. Displays will remain up for a specified time frame and must be retrieved by the specified time. Displays not retrieved at that time will be discarded.

Supplied by the contestant:

1. One-page résumé - Contestants must submit a one-page, typewritten resume
2. Each student will submit the following items to be judged and displayed at the competition.
 - a. One printed Coffee mug
 - b. One printed T-shirt
 - c. Two other printed items of the student's choice
 - d. One page typewritten "Artistic Statement" explaining their thoughts behind the design.
3. All designs on items **MUST** promote Tennessee SkillsUSA, and the phrase "Birthplace of SkillsUSA" must be included. **The same design is to be used for all items submitted.**
4. All printed items must have a label placed on back or inside them, that includes the following information:
 - a. Contestant number
 - b. Division (High School or College Post-Secondary)
5. The contestants will have 3' by 3' area (half of a table) to display items.
